Children/Adolescent Services

Individual and Family Counseling

Our counselors are trained clinical therapists, serving children and adolescents between the ages of 4 and 18. Adult services are also available.

Play Therapy

Therapists work with young children's social and emotional development as well as resolving early trauma including physical and sexual abuse.

Theraplay

The focus is strengthening the attachment and bond between the parent and their young children to promote resiliency and healthy development.

Adolescent Outpatient Drug & Alcohol Services

Our therapists and counselors aid families, youth and adults who are struggling with substance abuse in individual and group settings. The primary goal is prevention and intervention services.

Life Skills Group

This group covers conflict resolution, drug and alcohol education, family issues, values clarification, choices and consequences.

Sexually Reactive Youth

Early intervention with youth who display disruptive and aggressive sexualized behaviors.

Teen Court - Teen Court assigns constructive consequences that are designed to help the adolescent defendant learn from their mistakes.

Other Services we offer:

24-Hour Hotline - For adults, adolescents and family members. We offer crisis intervention, support, referrals, and safety planning.

Cost: We accept Medicaid and most private insurances. If a family does not have either, we have a grant that may cover you child's services at no cost to you.*

UA's -Urine analysis with immediate results. On-Site, dip-type drug tests – Test checks for Marijuana, Meth, Cocaine, Opiates, and PCP. For an additional fee these quantitative tests can be sent to the lab.

Outreach - Desert View determines the underserved populations in San Juan County and develops strategies to reach these populations; examples of underserved populations may include non-English speaking persons; teens; people of color; LGBT community; people with disabilities, and others.

Public Awareness - Public service announcements, "freebies" (pens, tote bags, magnets, etc.) and brochures are available for various events.

Training - All programs have staff available to do presentations in the community and provide professional in service training.

Practicum: Desert View is an approved site for practicum experience for both Highlands and San Juan College.
